For preparation of detailed Project Report (DRP), the consultant have to carry out design of such facilities, we request you to kindly consider detailed project report for the oil handling facilities as an eligible projects/ similar nature works.	The bidder must have atleast 07 years of experience in advisory services of (ending on 31 st May-2016) similar works means studies and augmentation of existing facilities utilized for liquid handling in jetties / marine terminals / industries with minimum project cost of Rs. 20.00 crores for which study has been done in India / Abroad are invited. Submit copy of work orders, completion certificates as submit documentary evidence along with technical bid.
2	In clause 7.1 No.2 Team leader with Masters/post Graduation in civil is required. We request you to allow B. tech-Mechanical/Civil with over 12 years of experience for the same. In general engineering/designing practice, the piping works are carried out by the Mechanical Engineers.	Clause No. 7.1 No.2(A) amended as below: Team Leader –Master/Post Graduate in Civil / Mechanical Engineering with Minimum 10 Years experience OR Bachelor in Civil / Mechanical Engineering with Minimum 15 Years experience and at least three completed projects of similar nature of work at national/ international level.-14 Marks thereafter for additional each completed project – 2 Marks.
3	Section 7.1, No. 2B, specifies the qualification of Team Member as Bachelor in Civil Engineering with minimum 05 years of experience... The pipeline engineers are generally have mechanical engineering degree because they have to deal with material properties, stress issues, mechanical accessories etc Team Member– Bachelor in Mechanical Engineering with minimum 05 years of experience or Diploma in Mechanical engineering with minimum 10 years of experience...”	Clause No. 7.1 No.2(B) amended as below: Team Member - Bachelor in Civil / Mechanical Engineering with 05 Years experience having completed at least three projects of similar nature of work.-9 Marks thereafter for additional each completed project – 2 Marks.

4	<p>Section 7.1, No. 2D specifies requirement for a legal expert in the project Could you please provide the list of tasks the Legal Expert has to undertake or remove this expert from the team.</p>	<p>The Clause 7.1 No. 2(D) holds Good. Since pipelines have been laid by various terminal operators from Oil Jetties to “Y” junction and From “Y” junction to their terminal. Now in case of recommendations given by advisor for removal / change in diameter/rearrangement of pipeline etc., if party does not agree with and private party / KPT opt for legal proceedings if any, the advice from the legal Expert is necessary in such circumstances.</p>
5	<p>The time schedule given in clause No. 13 (d) i.e. 30 days is impractical. We shall require at least 3 months to deliver quality work to you. Please review.</p>	<p>The total time duration for completion of work has now been amended and same shall be 60 days from date of issue of work order. Advisor has to submit the draft report, drawings and presentations within 45 days and final report shall be submitted within 60 days from date of issue of work order.</p>
6	<p>Section- 11(a) required that two executive staff to be stationed at Gandhidham from date of work order to actual date of completion of work. Please note that some time will be required in mobilizing the site staff and therefore please allow minimum 15 days of mobilization time to enable us to mobilize the staff from outside. The duration of deployment of the staff is not clear. Please confirm if the duration of site placement of staff will 30 days commensurate with the time schedule stated in section 13 of RFP.</p>	<p>Please refer Sr.No.5. Letter of Acceptance (LoA) will be given initially and accordingly the advisor is expected to start the mobilization immediately. Upon the submission of the Performance Guarantee, Work Order will be issued and work should be start immediately. The time period between LoA and the Work Order shall be sufficient for the Advisor for the mobilization of the staff. Kindly refer Clause No.11(a) for deployment of staff which is self explanatory</p>
7	<p>Section 12 does not mention the data to be provided by KPT Please clarify if KPT will provide data on existing pipelines and pipe racks in CAD format along with ownership and usage details such as product properties, maximum permissible pumping rates etc. and structural details of pipe racks etc.. This data will be provided to the technical advisor along with the work order.</p>	<p>CAD format is not available. The available data / details / drawings with KPT, if any, will be given during the execution of the project.</p>

8	Section 13(a) specifies that draft report to be submitted within 20days from issue of the work order. Please some time will required free project staff from other duties before mobilization to this project, we there request you to allow a 15 days mobilization time and project timelines shall be linked to the start date.	Kindly refer clarifications given at Sr.6
9	Clause 21, page 52 liability of Advisor Please confirm that the limit of liability under this contract will be the contract Value.	Clause No.21, Page No.52 holds good.
10	We Request you reduce annual turnover 100 lack to 50 lack	Clause No. 3.4 holds good.
11	Consortium Shall be allowed.	Clause No. 3.11 holds good.
